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Abstract

Image media is a medium that can increase children's interest in reading and communication. Image media can be stimulated to develop optimally. One of the developments in reading interest to children is through picture media. The importance of picture media for children is that it can increase knowledge and make it easier for children to communicate with others. The purpose of this study is to find out which Image Media can increase reading interest in children in kindergarten. This study uses qualitative descriptive research with teacher and student research subjects. The data collection tools used by the author in the research are observation, interviews, and documentation. Introduction

Based on the Regulation of the Minister of National Education Number 58 concerning Early Childhood Education Standards (2009: 3-11), it is stated that one of the early childhood education standards contained in the level of developmental achievement, which contains the rules of early childhood growth and development from birth to the age of six (Indriani & Suteja, 2023). The child's development achieved is an integration of aspects of understanding, namely religious and moral, physical-motor, cognitive, linguistic, and social-emotional values. Language is a communication medium because it provides children with skills to be able to communicate and express themselves so that children can be part of their social group. Based on the researcher's observations on early childhood early childhood shows that children's ability to recognize the concept of letters and words as a stage of the initial reading process, is not in accordance with the stages of development that should be. The low initial reading ability of children can be found when teachers make assessments in the process of learning to read words, only 2 out of 17 children are able to read with good criteria (RAHAYU et al., 2023), namely children still have difficulty distinguishing letters and reading words that have been spelled One of the efforts that can be made to develop the potential and abilities of children include that teachers should have skills in providing stimulation in every aspect of development (Regulations Minister of National Education Number 58 concerning Early Childhood Education Standards). Judging from the existing problems, the initial interest in reading needs to be developed in the right way, namely by selecting learning media in the form of the right images (Makhroji et al., 2023). One of the media that can be used to increase interest in reading at the beginning is by using picture media (Fitri & Suharyani, 2023). The use of this picture media can bring children to a fun learning environment in early reading learning because the teacher uses a play strategy and the technique used is a word game that can provide an active and fun learning situation (Cahya Bulan et al., 2023). An active and fun learning situation will make learning meaningful for children. This is the main key to achieving the expected goals in kindergarten schools. Learning activities with picture media can stimulate aspects of the development of early reading skills and motivate children in learning to read.

Research Method

This research is descriptive qualitative research, which describes a symptom, condition, and existing situation. So that researchers can get a broad and in-depth picture of phenomena and realities in the field. The approach used in this study is a descriptive approach, which is a method that aims to give an overview of the character of one variable, group or event that occurs in society. The sample in this study is teachers and students, and the data collection procedures used are observation, interviews, and documentation. The data analysis used in this study consists of data reduction, data presentation, and data verification, and a conclusion is drawn.

Results and Discussion

Image media is an imitation of objects and scenes in terms of their appearance and size relative to the environment. Among learning media, image media is the most commonly used media. The benefits of images as a learning medium at an early age include: 1) creating attraction for children clear and easily recognizable images helping children understand abstract concepts through visual representations that they are familiar with, 2) making it easier for students to understand/understand children more easily remembering the information presented through pictures compared to text or verbal explanations only 3) making it easier for children to understand what pictures mean Concrete attracts children's attention, makes learning more interesting and fun, 4) clarifies important parts or small parts so that they can enjoy pictures help children connect lessons with the real world, so that children can relate what they learn to everyday experiences, 5) shorten a description.

This is in line with the development of vocabulary at the age of 4-5 years which develops in line with the ability to combine visual perception activities (what is seen) with language skills or thinking skills and transform these two things into children repeating simple sentences, mentioning words, and relationships that may exist between all of these things, which includes the ability to visualize and graphically. Referring to the facts in the field that there are several findings so that image media can be used as an effective and efficient medium in learning, especially teaching to improve vocabulary in early childhood including a) pictures are concrete describing what is taught, b) images overcome space and time to accelerate students' capture of the images shown, c) images overcome verbalism so that the five senses can observe it more clearly, d) images can be explained to explain a meaning, because the image directly sees the object, e) the images are easy to choose and present because they do not require complicated equipment, f) the images are easy to use, both for individuals and groups.
