Piketty underscores the necessity of implementing policies that target the reduction of economic inequality by means of wealth redistribution and enhancing access to education and employment prospects. In addition, (A. Y. Pratiwi et al., 2022) research emphasises the intricate nature of the connection between economic prosperity and social welfare. It reveals that elements like as health, education, and social interactions greatly influence the overall well-being of a community.

Local Community

According to Reni & Rahayu (2018) and Sandika et al., (2022), a local community is a complex entity consisting of social networks, cultural norms and values, and daily life practices closely related to their physical and social environment. In the context of development, Widyaningsih (2019) emphasizes the importance of involving local communities in the planning and implementation of development programs. Chambers highlights the significance of a participatory approach that enables local communities to actively determine their own development needs and priorities.
